Along the way we will also see the Catacombs, the Sistine Chapel, the Basilica of St. Peter, the Colosseum and much more. Please view our itinerary for a full outline of this wonderful opportunity!

### Sunday, October 8: Departure

Our journey begins when depart from Newark on our flight to Rome, Italy.

### Monday, October 9: Arrival in Rome

Welcome to Italy! Upon arrival at Rome Fiumicino airport we are met by our tour escort and transferred to our hotel. Time permitting, we will enjoy a Panoramic City Tour of Rome before checking into our hotel. Dinner is included tonight.

### Tuesday October 10: Rome: Catacombs, the Aqueduct Park

Today we'll visit the Aqueduct Park where

we explore the massive remains of a number of ancient aqueducts that were built during the Roman Empire. The park is about 240 hectares and it is located in the South East side of the city. In ancient times, it was a real crossroads for the water supply heading to the urban area. We'll continue with a special visit to the Catacombs, where we explore tunnels and see the carvings on the walls from early Christians. Dinner is on-own. Overnight at our Rome hotel.

### Wednesday October 11: Rome: Vatican & Sistine Chapel, Baroque Rome & Vicus Caprarius – City of Water

Our first visit today is to the ornate Vatican Museum and the famous Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's magnificent ceiling. Our next stop is the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest church in the world, which overlooks the enormous St. Peter's Square, the site where Peter was crucified upside-down. Free time for lunch. The day continues with a walking tour through the Baroque Rome including: Spanish Steps, Pantheon, Piazza Navona and the famous Trevi Fountain. Everyone knows the famous Trevi Fountain, less well known is the underground passages that stretch beneath the Trevi district. Of this intricate maze of ancient vestiges, the underground archaeological area of Vicus Caprarius – the

City of Water is a part: the structures of an imperial domus, the castellum aquae of the Virgin Aqueduct and the evocative exhibit, finds discovered during the renovation of the former Cinema Trevi. Wine and food tasting dinner at Rimessa Roscioli (included). Overnight at our Rome hotel.

### Thursday, October 12: Pompeii, Archaeological Site

This morning we'll reach by bus the archaeological site of Pompeii. We'll meet our local guide and head south for the spectacular ruins. Covered by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in AD 79, Pompeii remained buried, preserved, and undiscovered until 1748. Ancient Pompeii is actually unique, because strolling in its streets and entering its buildings, it is possible to give answers to many of our curiosities. About the water system, it is possible to include in the traditional tour, the sight of original water pipes, gardens drainage system, aqueduct water collectors, waterproof materials of fountains and public baths. In the afternoon we return to Rome for overnight. Dinner is on-own.

### Friday, October 13: Rome, Roman Forum, Colosseum, St. Peter in Chain

We visit the Roman Forum and see the Arch

of Titus, which boasts of Rome's victory over Jerusalem. We'll see the Basilica Julias, where Paul was likely condemned, and the Colosseum, where gladiators fought. We'll also visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains, which houses Michelangelo's statue of Moses, as well as the chains that may have bound Peter. After the visit, the bus will transfer back to the hotel. (For those who prefer to have free time in the city center, the transfer back to the hotel is not included) Dinner is on-own. Overnight in Rome.

### Saturday, October 14: Rome – Free Day

Today is a free day to explore the wonders of the Eternal City on our own. Tonight we gather together to enjoy a dinner (included) with music show at "Le Terme del Colosseo". Overnight in Rome.

### Sunday, October 15: Return to U.S.A.

After breakfast at the hotel, we transfer to the Rome Airport for our flights back home, filled with memories and insights from our time in Italy!
